- Enforcement and legal proceedings

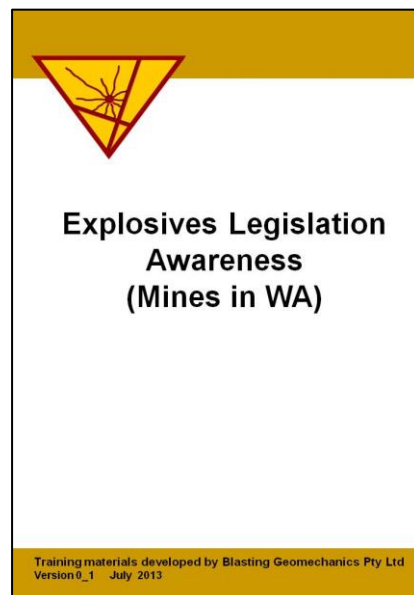
